Rik Bryan is a former clinical urologist and is now Professor in Urothelial Cancer Research and Director of the Bladder Cancer Research Centre at the University of Birmingham.

His cancer research spans 25 years since he was a junior surgeon studying the use of keyhole surgery and the laparoscope ('scopes) for staging stomach cancer, through his work in developing narrow band imaging endoscopy with Olympus, and on to two of his current main interests – using MRI scans and liquid biopsy biomarkers to streamline the treatment pathways for patients with bladder cancer.

These approaches continue to have a positive impact on patients nationally and internationally, and Rik will present and discuss these sometimes disruptive or controversial innovations in his lecture.
