A LIFETIME IN ORTHOPAEDIC SURGERY

Mr Mark Hamlet

Mr Hamlet did his undergraduate training at the Charing Cross and Westminster medical school in London. After qualifying in 1987 and after junior doctor jobs in Southampton, the New Forest, Sidcup and Croydon he joined the North West Thames Orthopaedic training programme.

He did a specialist fellowship attachment in Berne, Switzerland, studying under Professor Ganz and Professor Hertel, and in 1999 joined the Orthopaedic team in Queen's Hospital Burton as a consultant specializing in shoulder and knee problems.

After arriving in Burton he developed a shoulder department and now also sees and treats many of the soft tissue sporting injuries. Mark is also responsible for improvements to Members of the Society so watch closely and you may see part of someone you know.

Whilst old enough to have had a significant lifetime in Orthopaedic surgery he isn't giving up yet and thus his talk will encompass not only the huge changes in Orthopaedic practice that he has seen in his career but also those that he may yet see in the future.
